**Proposed development of buildings in the Dinnington area**

**I support:**

- Building on Brownfield land with priority being given to derelict and overgrown land
- New builds to be complementary in style and purpose to any existing homes in the locale
- Where building on Greenbelt cannot be avoided at any cost, preference should be given to scrub or grassland whilst retaining traditional recreation areas. Any building on agricultural land to be restricted to the lowest quality land
- At least 25% of new builds within the Borough being categorised as 'affordable' or 'social' until the lack of housing within the Borough has eased
- Priority being given to the needs of Rotherham Borough residents when allocating 'social' housing and other vacant properties.

**I Oppose:**

- Building on Greenbelt land whilst any Brownfield sites remain undeveloped
- Unnecessary building of factory units until vacant ones are utilised.

Any and all conditions stated apply to the use and classification of land as it is on the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2011.

The statistics published by the Borough (less than 1% of adult population went to the drop-in sessions, the majority of whom found out by 'word of mouth') demonstrate the 'consultation' held in the summer to be an abject failure. Consequently I call for a formal inquiry into the consultation process to commence immediately.

As bureaucrats created the decision that caused this situation, elected Councillors should take the final decision on 'what goes where' in principle using a free vote. Let the people speak!

I demand that the questions submitted by the Dinnington & Anston Action Group be answered in a full, accurate and concise manner together with supporting evidence.
